

ARTICLE VIII

LEGAL STATUS PROVISIONS

A. SEVERABILITY

Should any section or provision of these regulations be declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the regulations as a whole or part thereof which is not specifically declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

B. CONFLICT WITH OTHER REGULATIONS

Whenever there is a discrepancy between minimum standards or dimensions noted herein and those contained in other local, county, state, or federal regulations, codes or other official applicable regulations, the highest or more restrictive standards shall apply.

C. ADOPTION OF EFFECTIVE DATE

1. Before adoption of these subdivision standards a public hearing as required by Section 13-4-303, Tennessee Code Annotated, was afforded any interested person or persons and was held on **October 25, 2001**.
2. These rules and regulations shall be in full force and effect from and after their adoption and effective date.
